## Haemophagocytic lymphohistiocytosis and acute myeloid leukaemia. A case report

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
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## Abstract

We report a case of haemophagocytic lymphohisticytosis associated with acute myeloid leukaemia. The usual etiologies of haemophagocytic lymphohisticytosis, including viral infections, were negative. Haemophagocytic lymphohisticytosis secondary to acute myeloid leukaemia is often underestimated and undiagnosed. Haemophagocytic lymphohisticytosis may be masked by the tumour process, often making the diagnosis difficult.

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
