

Portal cavernoma secondary to multiple liver hydatidosis: A rare cause of cataclysmic haemorrhage in a young adult

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Abstract

We report a rare case of a 27-year-old male who died of variceal bleeding secondary due to portal cavernoma secondary to multiple liver hydatidosis. Hepatic hydatid cyst should be considered as an indirect cause of gastrointestinal bleeding in endemic countries.
